Shall be replaced by the following text:

There shall be one call for applications which shall be launched no later than in the first quarter of 2013 and make available the total grant amount of € 52,545,225. The call shall be open at least for 2 months.

6. In Annex 2 to the Programme Agreement, under the heading “5.1 Funds for bilateral relations”, in the first paragraph, under action 4, the tentative budget for point 3 and 4:

Shall be replaced by the following tentative budget for point 3 and 4:

€ 856,529

7. The modifications described in paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 above take effect from 25 June 2013.

#### Article 2

This Addendum constitutes an integral part of the Programme Agreement. Except for the stated above (Article 1), the Programme Agreement remains unchanged.

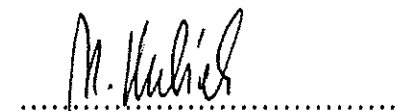
